

UCA Homecoming Campaign Rules

1. Each nominee and sponsoring organization must agree to abide by all campaign rules.
2. Campaigning cannot begin until after the Nominee Meeting hosted by Student Life.
3. All campaign materials should positively promote your campaign, and not speak negatively of others.
4. All campaign materials should include the name of the sponsoring organization.
5. All policies regarding signage and solicitation in the Student Handbook apply. Including, but not limited to:
 - a. Free Speech Policy (page 46).
 - b. Campus Outdoor Stake Sign Policy (page 48).
 - c. Distribution of Literature on Campus (page 49).
 - d. Solicitation Policy (page 137).
6. Door-to-door campaigning of any type is prohibited.
7. In-person tabling or campaigning inside any UCA campus building is prohibited, with the exception of the Student Center and Christian Cafeteria.
8. In-person tabling or campaigning in outdoor areas is allowed, but must follow the guidelines outlined in Board Policy #406 (Free Speech Policy). This includes blocking building entrances or sidewalks.
9. In-person campaigning must end when voting opens.
10. No nominee or sponsoring organization can establish a polling location or device(s) for voting. In addition, individuals shall not instruct other students to use personal devices where their vote could be seen by another student.
11. A polling location will be provided in the Student Center and staffed by Student Life staff if a student does not know how to cast their vote.
12. Complaints of campaign rule violations can be reported to the Office of Student Life.
 - a. Student Life staff will inform the nominee and sponsoring organization of the complaint within 24 hours so the violation can be addressed and corrected.
 - b. All complaints will be presented to the Student Life Committee who has authority to review the complaint. This committee may dismiss the complaint or decide if disciplinary action is needed.

- c. Disciplinary action may include: 1) warning, 2) disqualification from winning King/Queen, 3) disqualification from winning either top awards, and/or 4) disqualification from Homecoming Court.
 - d. Three (3) warnings will result in automatic disqualification from Homecoming Court.
13. As previously stated, each nominee and sponsoring organization must agree to abide by all campaign rules. Complaints will be addressed regardless of whether the nominee participated or had knowledge of the violation.
